

Canadian Navigable Waters Act

The Jacques Cartier and Champlain Bridges Incorporated hereby gives notice that an application has been made to the Minister of Transport, pursuant to the *Canadian Navigable Waters Act* for approval of the work described herein and its site and plans.

Pursuant to paragraph 7(2) of the said Act, The Jacques Cartier and Champlain Bridges Incorporated has deposited with the Minister of Transport, on the on-line Common Project Search Registry (<http://cps.canada.ca/>) and under registry number **7862** or under the NPP File Number 2023-309419 a description of the following work, its site and plans:

- Stabilization of the banks along the Bonaventure Expressway on the shore of the St. Lawrence River from the Victoria Bridge to 625 meters west of the Clément Bridge
