

WORK SCHEDULED TO START IN APRIL

New multipurpose path between the Samuel De Champlain Bridge and the T Sector in Brossard

Dear Sir/Madam:

The City of Brossard and The Jacques Cartier and Champlain Bridges Incorporated (JCCBI) wish to inform you of the construction of a new multipurpose path linking the Samuel De Champlain Bridge and the Route verte over the coming months. Work is scheduled to start in April 2025.

The aim of this project is to connect the multipurpose path on the Samuel De Champlain Bridge with the Route verte, which runs through part of the city of Brossard. This new path will run along Avenue Tisserand, providing a new access to the island of Montreal by active transport, avoiding a 3 km detour, to access the bridge via Boulevard de Rome.

Overview of JCCBI work schedule*

March	<u>Contractor mobilization at Parc de la Terre</u> Daytime work with moderate noise levels (delivery and installation of fencing by truck).
April to June	<u>Installation of pile caissons in the area of the Hwy. 10 East ramp to Hwy. 132 and the access to Hwy. 10 East from Hwy. 132</u> Daytime work with the possibility of high noise levels and vibrations during pile driving.
May to June	<u>Landscaping at Parc de la Terre</u> Daytime work with average noise levels (heavy machinery and truck traffic).
July	<u>Foundation and paving at Parc de la Terre</u> Daytime work with average noise levels (vibrations during compacting of granular materials, heavy machinery and truck traffic).
August	<u>Landscaped features and electrical work at Parc de la Terre</u> Daytime work with average noise levels (heavy machinery and truck traffic).
September to December	<u>Related work: road markings, safety audit and work on the footbridge (Hwy. 10 East ramp to Hwy. 132)</u>

	Daytime work with moderate-to-medium noise levels.
December	End of work
