Major reinforcement work on the metal structure of the Jacques Cartier Bridge



Work types



Reinforcement of the structure

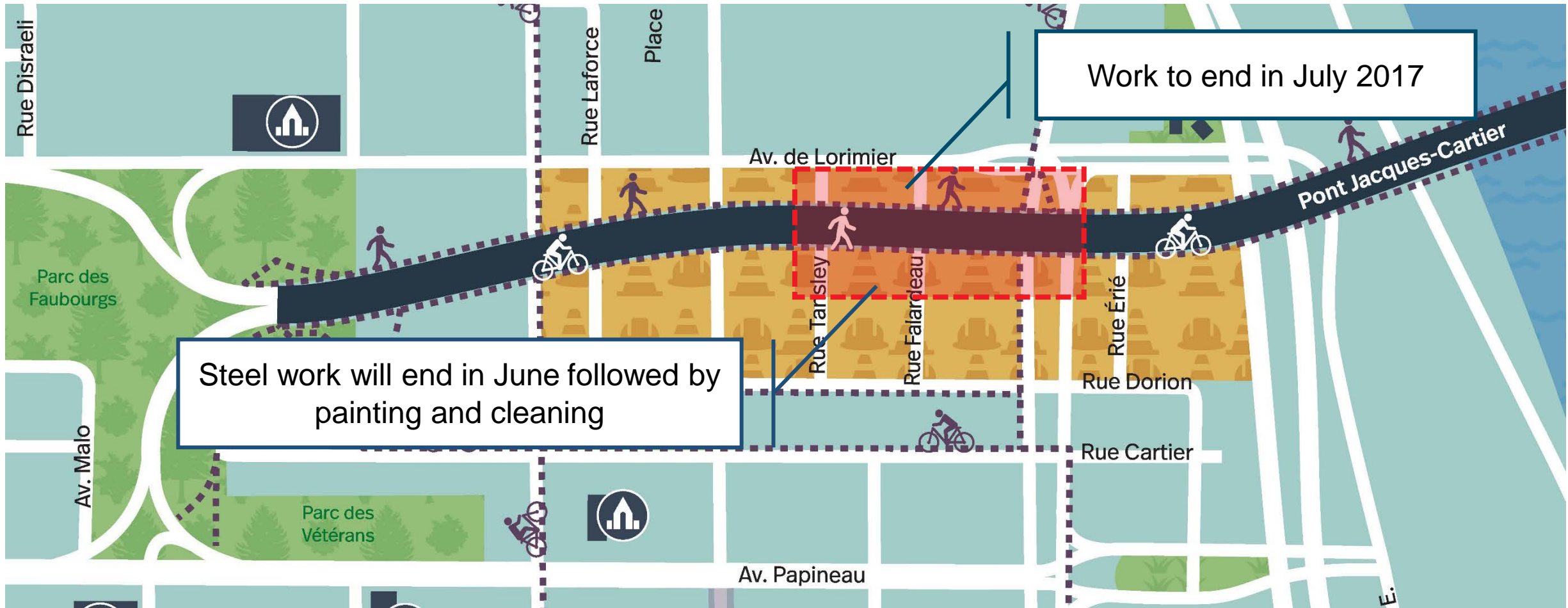
- + Removal of metal rivets
- + Temporary and permanent boltings
- + Installation of scaffolding
- + Installation of steel plates
- + Bridge jacking
- + Replacement of braces
- + Painting of some sections



Ongoing work (Phase 1)



90% of the work is complete



Site work management

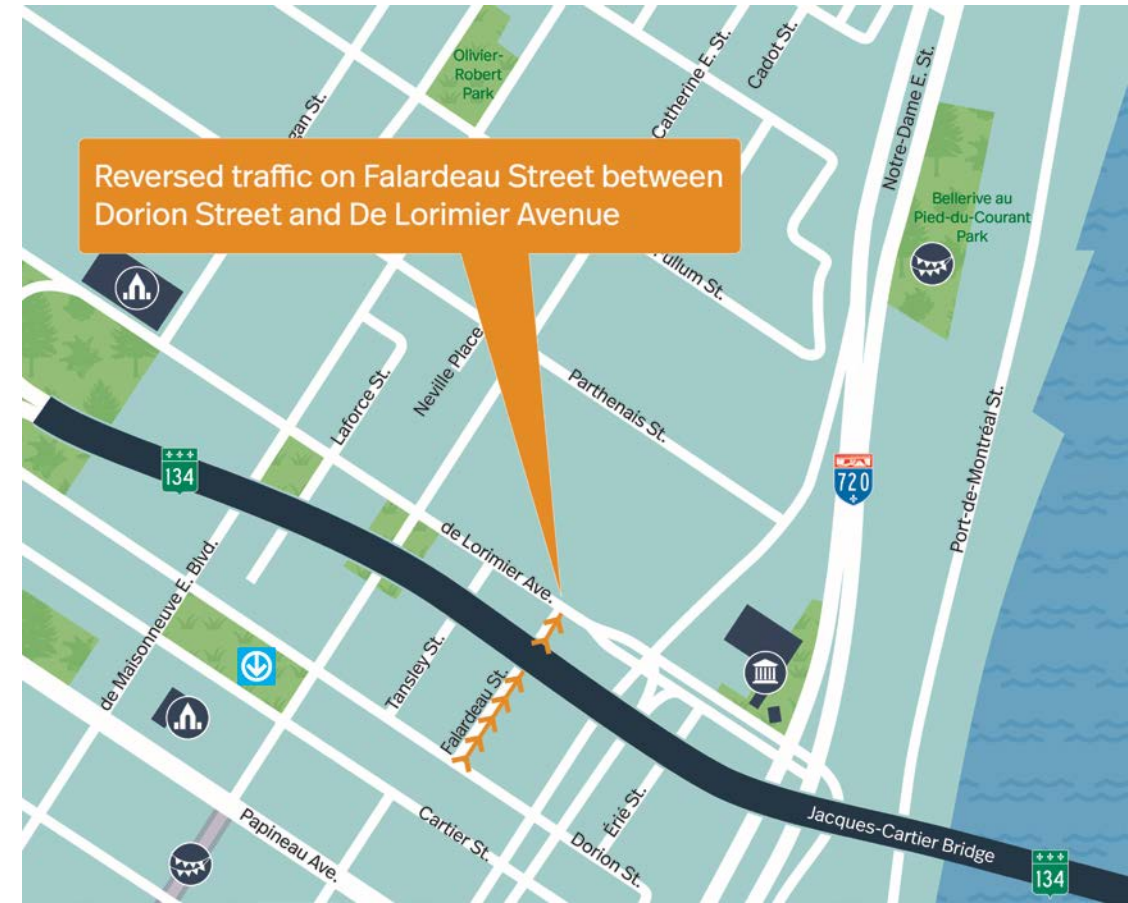


Latest comments

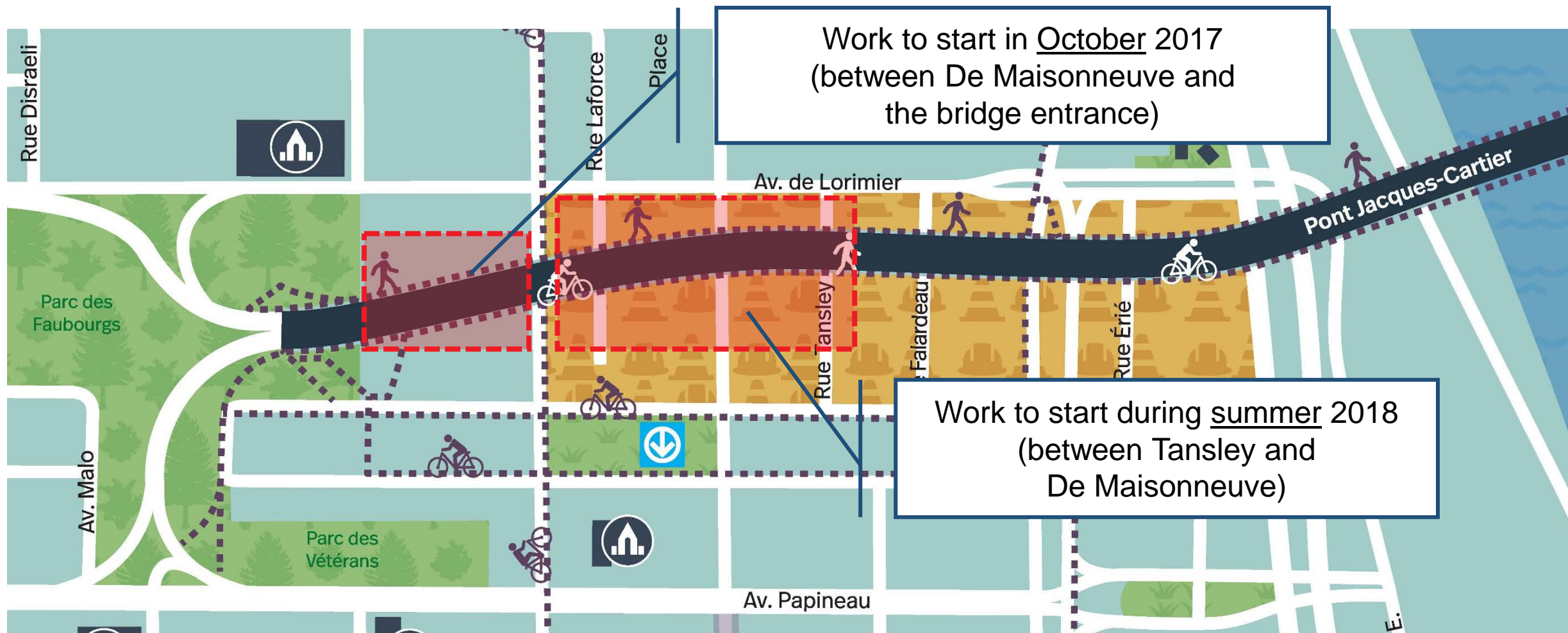
- + Hammering noise
- + Work schedule
- + Dust from the work
- + Traffic reversed on Falardeau

Mitigation measures

- + Optimization of work schedules (restriction of noisy work early in the morning)
 - End of sand blasting (May) and rivet work (June)
- + Cleaning of the site/sidewalk
- + Advisory to residents – Falardeau (mail/e-mail)



Work for 2017-2019

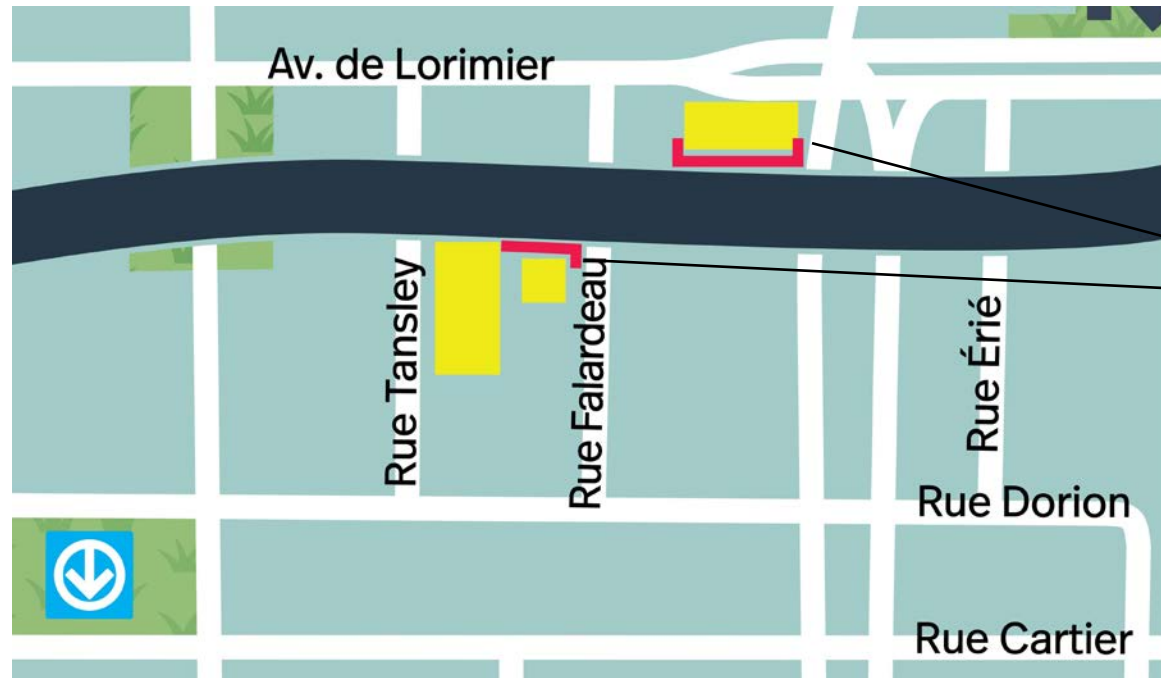


Temporary compensatory measures

An urban park to serve the community

- + Public consultation on the prefeasibility project to redevelop the land near the Jacques Cartier Bridge
 - Organized with the City of Montreal
 - Over 200 people at the April 20 meeting at the Lion d'Or
 - 5 round-table discussions about:
 - Entire project
 - Development under the bridge
 - Traffic networks
 - Development of local streets and area around the metro
 - City entrance
 - Very favourable response to the project

To help everyone co-exist





Long-term community action

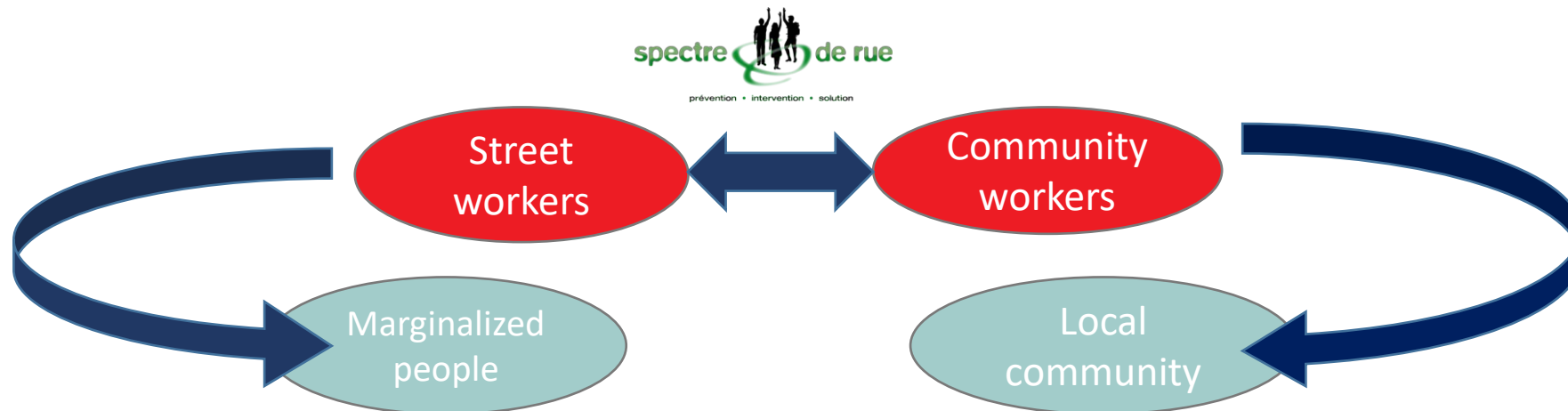
- + **Goal:** Help marginalized people on JCCBI land co-exist with the local community stakeholders (residents, local companies, etc.).
- + The organization's goal is not to get rid of marginalized people.
The goal is instead to help them and refer them to the appropriate resources.



Intervention for a lasting solution



- + **Street workers:** Their goal is to directly reach out to people who are suffering or who are living outside of society's structures. These workers offer general support and have direct experience working with people of all ages who are experiencing difficulty.
- + **Community workers:** Their goal is to find solutions to various problems or irritants related to the presence of marginalized people in the territory. These workers try to establish contact to listen to people while educating them about the realities experienced by this population with the goal of finding common ground for joint projects.

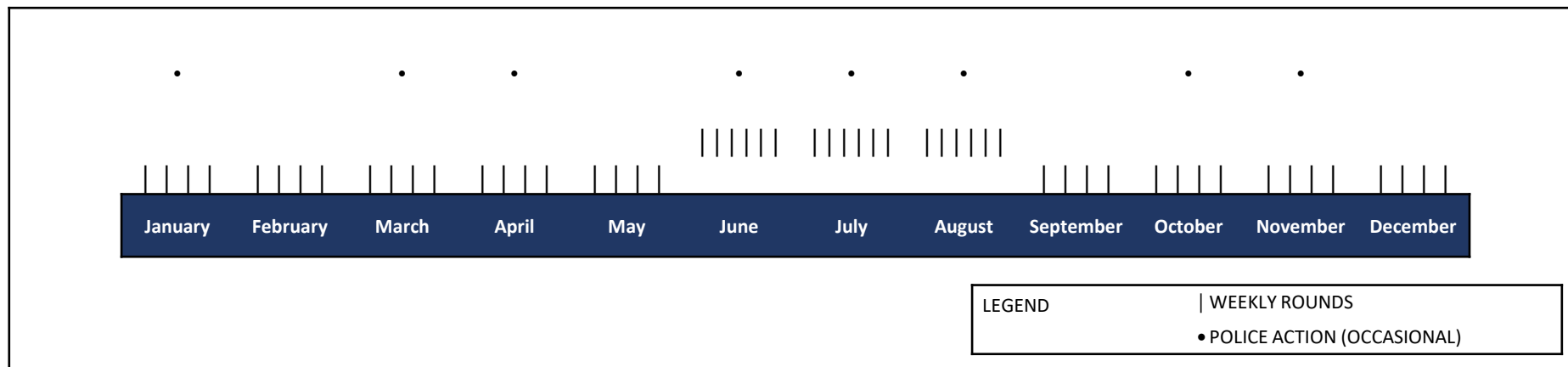
